Discovery

The [Haw River Trail](#) is a 70-mile long multi-use trail following the path of the Haw River. Alamance County is one of 12 local governments that make up the Haw River Trail Partnership. Currently, over 10 miles of trail exist or are in construction. In addition to these walking trails, paddling trips are available through the [Haw River Kayak and Canoe Company](#), located out of [Saxapahaw, NC](#). Their guided trips include Paddle Dinners, Owl Prowls and Whitewater Paddles, to name a few.
