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CRAFTED Spirits – Grass to Glass

Greensboro Distilling Co., (Fainting Goats Spirits – product line) is the first legal distillery in the Gate City since 1908. A family-owned and operated small batch, craft spirits distillery plans to open its doors in early summer 2016. Making the spirits from scratch is something that Fainting Goats Spirits takes pride in along with keeping all the production local even down to the grains – they are produced by local and/or North Carolina farmers.

Fabric CRAFTED in Greensboro

Greensboro was home to the textile industry for decades before production moved overseas. Civic Threads, a local retail shop carrying roughly 20-local vendors, including handmade apparel and Gate City Goods, another local shop focusing on handmade leather and denim goods joined forces in March of 2014 and created Hudson's Hill. When you walk into Hudson's Hill you are taking a walk back in time. When denim was worn by farmers and manufacturing was all done in the US. The shop pays homage to those years and takes pride in the way that their 100% handmade, small batch production operation runs. All equipment is original Singer machinery dating back to the 20's. Leather is also produced in-house and hides come from North Carolina cattle farmers. Future products include custom hats, socks and handmade shoes.
