## Dine & Stay in a Relais & Chateaux

**The Ferrington House Restaurant** is nationally recognized as one of the best restaurants in the Southeast. Chef Colin Bedford creates a fine dining experience of global cuisine with a foundation in the familiar. The extensive wine list features over 1,500 selections hand selected by Wine Director Paula de Pano.

**The Ferrington House Inn** is a Relais & Chateaux property that offers luxury amenities surrounded by gardens. There are 32 rooms and suites. The gardens that surround the Ferrington House feature native North Carolina plants and entice guests to wander from one peaceful vignette to another, all tucked in and around the Village. The herb and vegetable gardens provide produce to The Ferrington House Restaurant.

**The Belted Goat** restaurant is at the heart of Ferrington's Village Center. This casual eatery offers lunch, dinner, coffee, pastries and a wine shop. The signature Ferrington coffee blend is roasted on site, and the Belted Goat also offers an extensive wine shop specializing in small producers with most bottles under \$30.

**Roost Beer Garden** provides the ideal location to enjoy wood fired pizza, beer and live music al fresco. This seasonal beer garden serves local beers on tap and a variety of artisanal pizzas with inventive ingredient combinations, such as a sweet potato and pear with red sauce.

## To Shop

**McIntyre's Books** is one of the longest standing independent bookstores in the South. Celebrating its 30th anniversary this April, this gem of a bookstore offers a wide selection of fiction and non-fiction with an emphasis on children's books, cooking, mystery and local authors. Beyond its book offerings, McIntyre's hosts nearly 150 author events annually, giving local and nationally recognized authors a platform to share their stories.

**The Spa at Ferrington** is a day spa offering facials, massages, body treatments, manicures and pedicures in a serene setting. The only spa in the southeast offering Elemis facial and body line, the Spa also offers a full range of Elemis Biotec facials.

**Dovecote Style** offers designer apparel and accessories with seasonal trunk shows and pop-up shops. In-house stylists make this boutique a must visit. Tucked within Dovecote you'll find **Sprout**, a children's boutique with adorable clothing and toys for the youngest set. Just next door, **Nest** is a charming boutique packed with home décor and accessories, artwork, paper goods and unusual bar and service ware.

### To Live

Ferrington Village is a celebrated planned community of custom built homes that is consistently ranked as one of the best places to live in the Triangle area. Ferrington Village was started in 1974 by R.B. Fitch, who continues to build and open new neighborhoods.
